For support during the storm, please use the following emergency numbers and links:

## **Useful numbers**

In an emergency where there is a risk to life or property, dial 999

In a non-emergency, call 101

For urgent care advice and mental health support, call the NHS on 111

To report a power cut, dial 105

For telephone service issues, call Openreach on 0800 023 2023

For water supply emergency, contact your water provider – Southern Water (0330 303 0368), South East Water (0333 000 0365), Portsmouth Water (02392 477999)

For gas-related emergencies such as a gas leak call 0800 111 999.

You can report trees fallen into a major road to National Highways and on local roads to your local authority.

Your local authority will also have information on services they run, such as waste collection and venue closures
